## **SNAKES AND LADDER:**

Snakes and Ladders will be a board game played by candidates. Number displayed on die will allow the player to move forward and get closer to the finish.

## **RULES AND REGULATION:**

- 1. Snakes and Ladders will be played by two to four players, each with their own chance to move around the board.
- 2. Players roll a die or spin a spinner, then move the designated number of spaces, between one and six.
- 3. If the space a player lands on is at the bottom of a ladder, he should climb the ladder, which brings him to a space higher on the board.
- 4. If the space a player lands on is at the top of a snake/chute, he/she must slide down to the bottom of it, landing on a space closer to the beginning. Once they land on a space, they have to perform any action designated by the space.
- 5. The winner is the player who gets to the last space on the board first, whether by landing on it from a roll, or by reaching it with a ladder.
